

LEGACIES –THEY KEEP BLEAKHOLT GOING

Bleakholt totally depends on voluntary donations and legacies; we receive no government funding. Legacies are by far our largest single source of income, without which we certainly could not survive.

Our Cat buildings are heated and have outside play areas with lots of activity. There are also dedicated buildings and facilities for kittens, an isolation area and a hospital plus the special needs and 'oldies' rooms. These facilities can care for about 200 cats and kittens.

Our Dog accommodation consists of heated kennels, hospital, isolation block, treatment rooms, plus special facilities for puppies and 'oldies'. All dogs are exercised daily in the runs and walked by staff and volunteers. The dog section has facilities for about 100 dogs and puppies.

There are excellent stable blocks for the horses and ponies, plus separate stables for the donkeys. All overnight fields have field shelters. The goats have their own separate facilities and an outside area complete with their own goat mountain to 'act the goat' on. There are currently about 80 equine and farm animals to look after.

Rabbits and guinea pigs are accommodated in hygienic stainless steel hutches. They also have both inside and outside activity areas to provide plenty of stimulation. In recent years there has been a very large increase in ferret keeping and we therefore now have purpose made facilities for these cheeky little animals.

HOW YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

A valid up to date will is the only way to ensure the future happens exactly as you wish. It's also one of the best ways you could help Bleakholt.

A gift in your will to Bleakholt will help to safeguard the future of animals in distress, homelessness, neglect or even from being cruelly treated.

There are three principal types of Legacy:

Residuary Gift – is the gift of all (or part) of the value of your estate after all debts, liabilities and other legacies have been paid. This is usually the most valuable kind of legacy for the Sanctuary.

Pecuniary Gift – is the gift of a specified sum of money.

Specific – is the gift of a specific item of value such as property, jewellery or maybe a painting

Attached is a Codicil Form so that if you have a Will you can simply provide a Legacy to Bleakholt without it affecting your current Will.

Please ensure you fill in the details carefully and ensure the Codicil is signed by you and witnessed by two separate and independent Witnesses who also sign it.
