Main aims of the role

- To be part of the Bleakholt team that protects the welfare of animals in the Sanctuary, ensuring high levels of welfare are provided at all times
- Carry out animal care duties feeding, watering, cleaning of enclosures and bedding, exercise, grooming, training and rehabilitation
- Assist the vet, behaviourist and other specialists from time to time
- Provide high levels of customer service
- To undertake ancillary roles such as cleaning, laundry, response to adverse weather conditions, minor maintenance tasks etc.
- To be part of the rehoming process ensuring dogs are matched to suitable homes and all known information is provided to the adopter

Duties and responsibilities

Welfare and care of animals

- Check all animals assigned to role daily and identify, record and report any welfare concerns (e.g. illness, behavioural issues etc.) to Supervisors
- Carry out cleaning of enclosures, feeding, provision of water and change bedding daily
- Ensure each dog assigned to the section has had a minimum of one walk and time in the exercise area per day
- Adhere to any measures/ barriers to control infections, quarantine procedures etc.
- Assist vet and other specialists as required
- Administer medications to animals as directed
- Give care to and deal with animals with underlying health problems, behavioural issues etc.
- Work with behaviourist and deliver training to dogs on behaviour plans/ kennel club scheme

Communication with team members, volunteers and visiting public

- Communicate clearly to Supervisors about welfare issues, task completion etc.
- Ensure that medical and other records of animals are accurate and up to date including Anilog (our customised software)
- Respond professionally to enquiries from visiting public about the animals and Bleakholt in general including over the phone and on social media
- Participate in fundraising events such as the Open Days
- Follow volunteer colour code system at all times
- Adhere to Bleakholt's rehoming process making sure suitable dogs are matched to suitable owners

Other duties

- Carry out cleaning/ laundry/ housekeeping/putting deliveries away and minor maintenance operations such as painting and power washing from time to time
- Respond to adverse weather events such as ice, snow, storms, excessive rainfall and communicate with Supervisors and other team members as per protocols
- Co-operate with the Supervisors and Managers on all matters of Health and Safety
- Help promote animals for adoption and sponsorship
- Keep the dog section clean and tidy at all times, reporting any areas of concern to supervisors
- Keep dog runs and the field clean, have fresh water and are scooped at all times
- Ensure section is fully stocked at end of shift
- Take dogs from the kennels and exercise them, and /or handing over to volunteer dog walkers
- Assist with vet as required (this may at times include transporting dogs to Bury surgery)
